THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH (GRANGE ROAD) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it has made an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being a temporary prohibition of driving on Grange Road from a point 8 metres west of its junction with the western kerb line of Elder Court for a distance of approx. 7 metres in a westerly direction because of regeneration works. An alternative highway will be available for use while the Order is in force being Abingdon Road, Borough Road and Melrose Street.

The road will be closed from 06/06/2022 for up to 18 months. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport. The temporary closure will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road.
