HOME REPAIRS

The Staying Put Agency

Staying Put Agency works with Social Care and other organisations to provide a service to help older people (60+), people with disabilities (18+) and those who are vulnerable to remain and live more independently in their own homes.

The Agency gives advice on repairs, improvements or adaptations to your home (such as bathing, accessing the toilet, going up and down stairs) and will provide information about financial assistance and can offer support to investigate other sources of funding.

This handyperson scheme (run by the Staying Put Agency) offers essential minor repairs and minor adaptations. They offer a low level repair service for non-essential work at a small cost.
