

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH (MELROSE STREET)  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it has made an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being the eastern footway on Melrose Street from its junction with the southern kerb line of Grange Road for a distance of 76 metres in a southerly direction because of redevelopment works. An alternative highway will be available for use while the Order is in force being the footpath / cycle path located 75 metres to the east linking Grange Road and Borough Road.

The footway will be closed from 10/01/2022 for up to 52 weeks. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The temporary closure will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road. Access will be maintained for the emergency services.
