EMERGENCY HELP FROM SOCIAL CARESingle Point of Access (SPA) – During Office Hours

The Single Point of Access Team working hours are between 8.30am–5pm, Monday to Thursday and Friday 8.30am to 4.30pm. Telephone 01642 726004

Emergency Duty Team – Out of Office Hours

The Emergency Duty Team provide out of hours Emergency Duty Service covering evenings, weekends and bank holidays. Telephone 08702 402994

Middlesbrough Crisis Resolution and Access Teams – 24 Hour Service The Middlesbrough Mental Health Crisis Resolution and Access Service works 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Telephone 01642 680706

HELP FROM NHS: NHS 111

NHS 111 is a new service introduced to make it easier for you to access local NHS healthcare services when you need medical help fast, but it's not a 999 emergency. NHS 111 is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Calls are free from landlines and mobile phones.

HELP FROM POLICE AND FIRE BRIGADE

At some point, most people will need to get help because of an accident or a medical emergency. Only dial 999 in a critical or life-threatening situation.

ICE - In Case of Emergency

In Case of Emergency (ICE) is a programme that encourages people to store emergency contacts in their mobile telephone address book under the name "ICE. This enables emergency services to use your mobile phone to be able to contact your next of kin.
