

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH  
(PRITCHETT ROAD / B1380 LADGATE LANE / HIGH STREET)  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2021**

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it has made an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being 'no waiting at any time' restrictions on the lengths of road shown in the schedule below, due to parking issues.

The measures will be installed after 6<sup>th</sup> September 2021, up to a maximum period of 18 months. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport. The usual exemptions will be allowed for the emergency services, etc.

**SCHEDULE**

<b>Road Name</b>	<b>Length of Restriction</b>
Pritchett Road (west side)	From its junction with the northern kerb line of B1380 Ladgate Lane for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.
Pritchett Road (east side)	From its junction with the northern kerb line of B1380 High Street for a distance of 46 metres in a northerly direction.
B1380 Ladgate Lane	From its junction with the western kerb line of Pritchett Road for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction.
B1380 High Street	From its junction with the eastern kerb line of Pritchett Road for a distance of 15 metres in an easterly direction.
Unnamed access road to the side of 1 Pritchett Road (both sides)	From its junction with the eastern kerb line of Pritchett Road for a distance of 3 metres in an easterly direction.
